3 months before, the month of, and 3 months after your 65th birthday

□ Consider a Medigap (Supplement) plan
 If choosing Original Medicare, to help cover out-of-pocket costs
$\ \square$ Decide between Original Medicare (with Medigap plan) or Medicare Advantage (Part C
 Compare coverage, provider networks, and extra benefits
□ Consider a Part D (Prescription Drug) plan
☐ Even if you don't take prescriptions now, enrolling can help avoid penalties later
✓ After Enrollment
☐ Review your Medicare card for accuracy
 Set up an online Medicare account at <u>Medicare.gov</u>
☐ Notify your healthcare providers of your new coverage
☐ Review coverage annually during Open Enrollment (Oct 15 − Dec 7)
✓ Avoid Penalties
Enroll in Part B and Part D on time, unless you have qualifying coverage
